#### **TEST REPORT**

Test report for cosmetic container manufactured from main material identified as: PS (Polystyrene) / SAN (Styrene-acrylonitrile resin) / ABS (Acrylonitrile-Butadiene-Styrene).

Based on the performed test on submitted samples, the results of Cadmium, Lead, Mercury, Hexavalent chromium, Polybrominated biphenyls (PBBs), Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDEs) and Phthalates such as Bis(2-ethylexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) comply with the limits set by RoHs Directive (EU) 2015/863 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU.
